Slowing Down To Do Better

I recently read this and thought that I would share it. We can all benefit from taking our time and not being so focused on the task at hand that we miss the ministry opportunity that God has given us.

An ethics professor at Princeton Seminary asked for volunteers for an extra assignment. Fifteen students showed up. He divided the group of fifteen into three groups of five each. He instructed the first group of five to proceed immediately across the campus to a certain spot; if they didn't get there in fifteen minutes their grade would be affected. A minute or two later he instructed the second group to proceed across the campus to the same spot; but they were given forty-five minutes to get there. After they left, he instructed the last group to go across the campus to that spot too; but they were given three hours for the trip.

Now, unknown to any of these students, the teacher had arranged with three students from the Drama Department to meet them along the way, acting as people in great need: the first one they met covered his head with his hands and moaned out loud as though in great pain; the second, a little bit further along the way, was on some steps lying face down as if unconscious; the third, on the very steps of the destination, acted out an epileptic seizure. You know what the ethics professor discovered? Not one of the first group stopped, two of the second group stopped, and all five of the third group stopped. What the experiment tells us is that when we are too busy, with tight schedules and impossible deadlines, there is no time for **love**.



Each item is prayed over while it is being made. It is then followed by prayer and a card when given to the individual whom receives it.

When you check out the website, <u>www.shawlministry.com</u>, you will find a wonderful definition of the prayer shawl concept written by Janet Severi Bristow in 1998. It says: "Shawls ... made for centuries universal and embracing, symbolic of an inclusive, unconditionally loving, God. They wrap, enfold, comfort, cover, give solace, mother, hug, shelter and beautify. Those who have received these shawls have been uplifted and affirmed, as if given wings to fly above their troubles..."

The Prayer Shawl ministry was started in 1997 and enveloped "Compassion and the love of knitting/crocheting have been combined into a prayerful ministry and spiritual practice which reaches out to those in need of comfort and solace, as well as in celebration and joy. Many blessings are prayed into every stitch" (shawlministry.com). Shawls can be referred to as many different things, including comfort shawls, peace shawls, or mantles, etc. But whatever the name, love, prayers and blessings are connected to each and every stitch that makes the shawl.
